


# **Voltage Transducer LV 100-400**

For the electronic measurement of voltages: DC, AC, pulsed..., with a galvanic isolation between the primary circuit (high voltage) and the secondary circuit (electronic circuit).

- High immunity to external interference.



#### **Remarks**

- $\bullet$   $\mathbf{I}_{_{\mathrm{S}}}$  is positive when  $\mathbf{V}_{_{\mathrm{P}}}$  is applied on terminal +HT.
- The primary circuit of the transducer must be linked to the connections where the voltage has to be measured.
