PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

The AWT6282 HELP3™ PA is the 3rd generation WCDMA product for UMTS handsets. This PA incorporates ANADIGICS' HELP3™ technology to provide low power consumption without the need for an external voltage regulator. The device is manufactured on an advanced InGaP HBT MMIC technology offering state-of-the-art reliability, temperature stability, and ruggedness. There are three selectable bias modes that optimize efficiency for different output power levels, and a shutdown mode with low leakage current, increase handset talk and standby time. The self-contained 4 mm x 4 mm x 1 mm surface mount package incorporates matching networks optimized for output power, efficiency, and linearity in a 50 Ω system.




Figure 1: Block Diagram




Figure 2: Pinout (X-ray Top View)

Shutdown Mode

The power amplifier may be placed in a shutdown mode by applying logic low levels (see Operating Ranges table) to the Venable, Vmode1 and Vmode2 voltages.

Bias Modes

The power amplifier may be placed in either a Low Bias mode or a High Bias mode by applying the appropriate

logic level (see Operating Ranges table) to the V_{MODE} voltages. The Bias Control table lists the recommended modes of operation for various applications.

Three operating modes are recommended to optimize current consumption. High Bias/High Power operating mode is for Pout levels \geq 16 dBm. At ~16dBm - 7 dBm, the PA should be "Mode Switched" to Medium Power/Medium Bias Mode. For Pout levels \leq ~8 dBm, the PA can be switched to Low Power/Low Bias Mode for even lower quiescent current consumption.





Figure 3: Application Circuit Schematic


